1. New Features in Minitab Engage October 2024

Custom dashboard summary palettes

Assign custom colors to distinct groups in dashboard summaries to make your graphs and tables clearer and more meaningful.

Enhanced column set formatting

Apply any number of conditions to your column set to meet the requirements of your scenario. For example, choose from a variety of icons or colors to show varying degrees of savings or past due warnings.

Summary editor improvements

Apply the following options in the summary editor to make graphs and tables easier to understand.

- Exclude empty groups
- Sort in ascending or descending order

2. Problems Resolved in Minitab Engage October 2024

The following issues are resolved in Minitab Engage October 2024.

- Requests for related documents in Engage 6.5 are sent to Engage instead of Drive. (187342)
- Existing graphs on dashboard reports show additional white space. (187278)
- Managed Data for Projects is not restored with a project. (255346)
- Subscriptions that are missing the Duration Less Days Paused field may fail when a sandbox is created. (256653)
- The Show Headings section wraps in the summary builder in non-English translations. (241893)
- Not all variables are shown in snapshot summaries. (259864)
- Transposing the table on a pie chart breaks the legend. (257290)

- The Paste Special option is grayed out when copying/pasting text from PowerPoint to a Rich Text field. (187310)
- Date formatting of Completed Phase Due Dates is incorrect. (261186)
- Hopper charts do not display all ideas in the hopper. (259823)
- In a column with positive and negative values, Dashboard and Workflow sort blank values differently. (265201)
- Reset Zoom is not translated for summaries. (265371)

3. Known Problems and Workarounds

Item 1

Creating team members from Address Book on the Team Members & Roles form does not support 64-bit Outlook. (180074)

WORKAROUND: Enter team members manually.

Item 2

Exporting a process map to PDF might crash if the text is bold or italic. (182872)

WORKAROUND: Remove bold and italic formatting before you export to PDF.

Item 3

The desktop app might crash when there are many large images in a Rich Text Box on a form. (182323)

WORKAROUND: Divide the images up among multiple Rich Text Boxes.

Item 4

The Monte Carlo Simulation's "Edit Model" page opens and performs slowly when there are many equations in the model. (182400)

Item 5

Using the calendar's date picker when the regional setting's date format does not follow the western calendar results in the wrong year. (182136)

WORKAROUND: Manually type the date instead of using the date picker.

Item 6

Exporting value stream maps to Word, PowerPoint, or PDF produces an error when a non-process shape exists to the right of the rightmost process shape. (181451)

WORKAROUND: Turn off the Takt Time box or move all non-process shapes to the left or below the rightmost process shape.

Item 7

Copying items on a form when using Remote Desktop causes the application to crash. (178344)

Item 8

On a form, adding a row below an optional section in a layout table causes the application to crash. (182384)

Item 9

The spell checker does not work for non-English default dictionaries in forms and brainstorming tools. (178764)

Item 10

On process maps and value stream maps, when the fill of a shape is a color and the font is set to white, the text is not visible in edit mode. (183145)
